ACTIVITIES

Daurah Talaqqi Kitab: Aqidah Tahawiyah

This program was held at Lecture Hall 1 on 7th September 2019. The objectives of this program are to strengthen beliefs through the teachings of Ahli Sunnah Wal Jamaah and to avoid misunderstanding in society. This program targeted participants were mainly ISRAK members and also open for all CFS students. The program received good feedback from most of the participants.

Karnival Sukan Israk (KASURA)

This program was held at Al-Fateh Sport Center on 8th December 2019. It includes a variety of sports. This program holds a very important objective in implementing the concept of brotherhood between society members. This program was organized for ISRAK society members only. It was one of the highlight programs in ISRAK society because it achieved our main objective to tighten the bond between members. Besides, it was an initiative to encourage members to involve themselves in sports.

Malam Munajat ISRAK (MMI)

This program was held twice at Masjid CFS during the end of semester 1 and semester 2. This program was held in order to perform Solat Hajat Perdana in conjunction towards the final exam week. It is compulsory to all society members.

Youth Camp 2020 (Facilitator Training)

This training was held on 8th February 2020 at Studio 3, Al-Ghazali. This training objective was to provide guidance for chosen facilitators in conjunction to the Youth Camp program that will be held at SMA Al-Maarif, Bukit Goh Kuantan. Participants were guided by an experienced trainer that is Brother Nasri.

Youth Camp 2020

Youth Camp is a volunteer programme that we offered to the members of ISRAK society. The programme was carried out on the grounds of SMA Al-Ma'arif, Felda Bukit Goh Kuantan, Pahang, on 22nd to 23rd of February 2020. The programme consist of 30 ISRAK members and 80 students from the school which were also our targeted participants for the programme. We also invited a guest from Ikatan Pelajar Pahang IKATAN to give a speech to the students at the school. The main objectives of the programme are to encourage the youth in their involvement, participation, and collaboration, to provide exposure on campus life, to instil critical thinking and to develop problem solving skills amongst the students, and to increase our belief and taqwa towards the Him. We are proud to say that the objectives of the programmes were successfully obtained.

Daurah Fiqh Wanita

Daurah Fiqh wanita is an education programme for everyone even though it is called *fiqh wanita*. We invited a lecturer whom is an expert in this knowledge to give the explanations, Syeikh Abdul Rahman Al-Osman. The programme was carried out on the 24th of August 2020 in Lecture Hall 1, Al-Jurjani Building. The programme was a joined venture programme which we collaborate with HARMONI club. We had over 600 students that participate during the event and it exceeded our expectation and target. The objectives for the programme were to enlighten the students about the problem that occurred during menstruation, to convey the wisdom about menstruation and also to be able to achieve the blessings from Allah. We are also proud to announce that most of the objectives were successfully obtained.

Islamophobia ft Aina Wafi

Islamophobia was also an education programme in which it talks about the factors that leads to islamophobia, the effects on the society etc. We invited Aina Wafi, a social media influencer to give her speech on the topic given. The programme was also a joined venture programme which we collaborated with GCC. The programme was held on 21st of December 2019 at Al-Khawarizmi Hall, CFS IIUM Gambang, Pahang. The participants during the programme exceeded our expectations which was only 500 students but the number of students exceeded to almost 1000 participants. We are very thankful towards the ability of the staff of CFS IIUM to do their part which was setting up the venue and there were no shortcomings that occurred.

Talk on Zakat by Lembaga Zakat Pahang

This programme is one of the important programmes because understanding zakat is very crucial for us. The talk was held by Lembaga Zakat Pahang in collaboration with ISRAK society and ECONS society. The programme was also held on 21st of December 2019 in Al-Khawarizmi Hall CFS IIUM Gambang, Pahang. Our targeted participants during the programme were the students of CFS IIUM Gambang, Pahang. The programme was filled with new knowledge because it explains about zakat, the amount of zakat, the types of zakat etc. Some of our confusions regarding zakat were also solved. There were no shortcomings for the event.

CFS Fest Booth Sale & Ihtifal Ilmi

CFS Fest Booth Sale and Ihtifal Ilmi were both under SCC's programmes which is the CFS Festival. Both of the programmes were held on CFS IIUM's compound. we collaborated with INTECHS society and our booth was based on Johor theme. We sold many things but mainly foods.
