



**IIUM OFFICIAL GUIDELINES
FOR NEW AND RETURNING STUDENTS FOR SEMESTER 1, 2020/2021
DURING THE RECOVERY MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER 01/2020**

** This guideline is applicable for registration of new intake and returning students for Semester 1 2020/2021.*

SECTION 1: BACKGROUND

1. This guideline is based on the decision of the Ministry of Higher Education on 8th July 2020 regarding the conduct of academic activities in the campus for Semester 1, 2020/2021 session, during the Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) period.
2. Semester 1 2020/2021 at IIUM will begin on 12th October 2020.
3. Generally, all students are allowed to be on campus beginning October 2020 for face-to face teaching and online learning sessions **EXCEPT** for those from **COVID-19 RED ZONE** area.
4. As per the Ministry of Higher Learning's circular dated 27th September 2020, the Minister has instructed all universities to postpone the registration of new students and the returning of existing students from **COVID-19 RED ZONE** area.

SECTION 2: SEMESTER 1, 2020/2021 REGISTRATION DATE

1. Registration dates and time for **new intake students** at Gombak are as follows:

2. Registration dates and time for **returning students** are as follows:

SECTION 3: ENTERING THE CAMPUS

1. All new intake students and returning students **MUST** undergo body temperature check at the campus gates.
 - a. Accompanying persons (e.g. family members) must also undergo body temperature check at the gates.
 - b. Students with body temperature above 37.5°C will not be allowed to enter the campus.

SECTION 4: ENTERING THE MAHALLAH

1. All new intake and returning students **MUST** scan MySejahtera QR code at their respective *mahallah* using their smartphones.
 - a. Accompanying persons must drop off students and wait at the designated parking space (*list of drop off points is appended below*).
 - b. **ONLY** students are allowed to enter *mahallah* office for registration process.
 - c. **ONLY** one accompanying person are allowed to enter *mahallah* room with student during registration day.
 - d. Students with luggage will be assisted to their rooms by *mahallah* representatives.
 - e. Accompanying persons must remain at their vehicles throughout the registration process.
 - f. Once student registration is completed, it is highly advisable that accompanying persons leave the campus immediately.

SECTION 5: STUDENTS FROM RED AND HIGH-RISK ZONES

1. New intake students from Sabah, Kota Setar and other High-Risk or Red Zone areas are NOT allowed to be on campus.
2. Returning students from Sabah, Kota Setar and other High-Risk or Red Zone areas who are yet to return to campus are not allowed to be on campus.
3. Students are required to follow Crisis Preparedness and Response Centre (CPRC) Telegram or website <https://t.me/cprckkm> for updates on the latest COVID-19 Green, Yellow and Red Zones.
4. Students from Sabah, Kota Setar and other High-Risk or Red Zone areas are required to complete their registration online and to follow classes online.
5. Students from Sabah, Kota Setar and other High-Risk or Red Zone areas are required to be aware of official announcement from IIUM on when they will be allowed to be on campus.
6. Symptomatic students are NOT ALLOWED to return to campus, even if they are not from Sabah, Kota Setar and other High-Risk or Red Zone areas. They are advised to get treatment at the nearest health facilities near their homes. They have to show evidence of such treatment when they return to campus.

SECTION 6: CONDUCT OF STUDENTS AND STAFF ON CAMPUS

1. All staff and students must practice:
 - a. Physical distancing of 1 metre apart at all times;
 - b. Avoiding the 3C (**C**rowded, **C**onfined and **C**losed conversation);
 - c. Practising the 3W (**W**ash hands, **W**ear mask & **W**arn);
 - d. Observe appropriate coughing and sneezing etiquette.
2. All staff and students experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must immediately report themselves to the IIUM Health and Wellness Clinic (IHWC) or other IIUM health facilities.

SECTION 7: CONCLUSION

1. IIUM urges that all staff and students put their safety and the safety of their families and fellow colleagues as the main priority at all times. This is necessary in order to minimise the risk of COVID-19 infection among staff and students, and their family members, as well as to ensure safe operation of the University.
2. Staff and students must practice **Cleanliness**, ensure **Obedience** to all instructions, always be **Vigilance** of their whereabouts, *Istiqamah*/Integrity in translating instructions into practice, and **Discipline** themselves at all times.
